



Block Party Trailer Guidelines

Rental Guidelines

1. Each church will pay a nonrefundable fee of \$100 each time they use the block party trailer, which will cover up to one week of trailer use.
2. Block party trailer reservations can be made online at www.uovba.com/book-online, by email at upperohio@gmail.com, or in person at the associational office.
3. Reservations require a definite date and time for both picking up and dropping off the trailer.
4. Pertinent insurance information is provided in a binder that must stay with the block party trailer at all times.

Usage Guidelines

1. A UOVBA Bounce House Daily Checklist must be completed each day prior to usage of the rides by an adult who has completed block party trailer training.
2. Equipment set up, operation, and tear down requires the presence of an adult who has completed block party trailer training.
3. No person under the age of 18 is allowed to transport the block party trailer or operate any of its contents without adult supervision.
4. All equipment must remain with the trailer and not be loaned to other churches.
5. Anything damaged or broken must be reported to the UOVBA office in a timely manner.
6. The trailer must be blocked and secured before unloading equipment.



7. It is highly recommended that utilized items be cleaned both before and after the event.
8. Each bounce house has a limit to the number of children that can participate at a single time. Workers must adhere to all bounce house rules.
9. Block party trailer equipment may not be used in unsafe weather conditions.
10. Bounce houses may not be set up near power line hazards.
11. The correct power source and power cords are required to operate all equipment.
12. Food equipment may not be stored while still hot.
13. Prior to storage, all items must be cleaned and dried to prevent mold and bacteria.
14. Avoid placing hot equipment on bounce houses.
15. Bounces houses must be rolled up correctly and tied with the correct straps. No ratchet straps are permitted.
16. Items should be stored on the trailer with even weight distribution to enhance safety.
